The company offers intuitive instruments that meet performers' needs, and supports musicians through training courses, educational content and a diversified repertoire. The team is driven by the desire to give performing musicians the possibility of controlling the electronic part of a performance themselves, and to rediscover the pleasure of playing music.

Alter Instruments products are handcrafted in Saint-Etienne, France, from the design of custom components, through programming of dedicated software, to manual assembly and finishing.


Alexander Mihalič

A trained composer with a doctorate in musicology, Alexander Mihalič is the creator of the Sampo and Modalio. After several years at IRCAM as a teacher and musical assistant in the pedagogy department, he is in charge of the computer music department at the Centre national de création musicale IMEB, where he develops software for so-called "Cyber" instruments.

Passionate about the link between science and the arts, he conducts research into the problem of data sonification at IMéRA in Marseille, and in 2014 created the Art & Science Days festival as well as an electroacoustic composition competition.

Following his experience in the field of gestural interfaces and his musical encounters, he conducts research into the digital augmentation of acoustic instruments. This research led him to co-found
